

LSMS Interventions for Success 2008-2009

Attend Grade Doctor Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:30-3:35

Work in the LSMS library; get help with assignments.

Take the 3:35 activity bus home, with a pass from the Grade Doctor supervisor.

Do a daily planner check

Have your student show you what homework has been assigned as well as what the learning activities were in each class period. The planner should be filled in daily!

Get a weekly grade check

From the counseling center, pick up a form for each teacher to fill in, showing effort and work for the week. Show the form to your parents.

Email teachers

Teachers respond to email within 24 hours of receiving them. Most addresses are firstname_lastname@lkstevens.wednet.edu If you have a question or concern, ask!

Request a parent-teacher conference

Just call the counseling office at 425-335-1588 to request a meeting with your child's teachers before or after school.

Set up a regular study time and place at home.

Set up a regular time (the hour before dinner? From 7-8 pm? As soon as s/he gets home from school?) and a regular place (dining room table? Desk in her/his bedroom? Kitchen table?) where homework is completed. If there are no assignments due tomorrow, work on long-term assignments, read, re-do assignments that weren't done well, go on-line to a math site, or write in a personal journal. If there's a regular time every day when work is completed, then a good habit is set.

Join an after-school activity

Currently we have Friendship Club meeting on Mondays, Science Club on Tuesdays, and Art Club on Thursdays. Students take the 4:30 activity bus home. Seventh grade students can participate in inter-scholastic athletics. November-January is boys basketball and girls volleyball; February-March is girls basketball and boys wrestling.

Every student has a code for accessing grades on-line. Parents can also see what their child's current grade is in each class by going to www.lkstevens.wednet.edu and selecting Grades Family Access from the left bar. Parents can get their access codes from Mrs. Wyrick in the LSMS office.
