Dear Sunnycrest Families:

Last Friday was a first for many of us: shutting down a school of 635 students! As many of you know, Sunnycrest was closed on Friday, October 2 due to a broken water main (entirely unrelated to Sunnycrest construction—past or present!). Sunnycrest sustained absolutely no water damage, for the break occurred several blocks south of Sunnycrest on 99th Ave. We closed because the PUD shut off water to repair the broken water main, and the estimated repair time was the duration of the school day. Sunnycrest students will not be required to make up this day. With Friday's closure, I would like to remind all parents to please keep your child's emergency contact information current and updated.

Weather Related Bus Schedule Changes

Lastly, please check with your child's classroom teacher prior to bringing snacks/treats of any kind into the classroom. Your complete cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
