We are excited to have our **third, fourth and fifth graders joining us!** Our K-2 students are off to a great start and it will be nice to have everyone who wants to back. This document is a resource to both parents and students about how everything will work in the hybrid model. If you already read the K-2 version please know that this one has been updated with 3rd-5th information. As you go from section to section you will find important videos for everyone to watch. **Look for the 🌟 to signal you that there is a video to watch.**

Here are some quick videos that every student needs to know to teach them the how and why of keeping 6 feet distance, wearing a mask, and proper handwashing. We expect a large number of parents using our **student drop off** area. Please form one line on the right and pull all the way forward. We have several staff members ready to guide students as they walk through the campus. Students can actually [watch the video](#) to see where they are going before they get here!

All students will head to the outside doors to our cafeteria. As students approach they will notice the white socially distanced markers change from white to blue and yellow. Mr. Brandt's, Mrs. Rabb's and Mrs. Kendall's classes follow the **YELLOW** dashes into the cafeteria. Ms. Scott's, Mrs. Selings's, Mrs. Llamas's, Mrs. Acosta's, Mrs. Doucette's and Mrs. Darland's/ Mrs. Kirk's classes follow the **BLUE** dashes towards the gym. While Ms. Scott's, Mrs. Selings's, and Mrs. Llamas's classes head into the gym, Mrs. Acosta's, Mrs. Doucette's and Mrs. Darland's/Mrs. Kirk's classes will line up at their ramps outside their classrooms. Again there will be people all along the way to guide students to the right spots.

On their way in they will pass by a temperature scanner where they will pause and see their face on the scanner as it takes their temperature. Once they have reached the cafeteria or the gym, then staff will help students line up on socially distanced markers while they wait for their teacher. Once their attestations have been checked their teacher will walk them to class.

Daily Health Survey Our new daily habit!



To keep us safe as a community, we need to know **daily** about your student's health status. Please use this Sunnycrest-specific link or QR code to share your child's health status each morning by **8:00 AM**, regardless if they are in AM or PM cohort.

Your student will not be allowed to join their class until we have received their health attestation information.

🌟 [Dismissal](#)

At dismissal, teachers will walk students getting picked up back to the gym or cafeteria to line up where we can be socially distanced. We simply do not have room for this in our parent pick up loop. Teachers will then continue on to the bus loop for students taking the bus.

Parents who are picking up, we need you to place a large sign in your passenger side window with:

Student(s) Last Name
First Name(s)
Teacher Last Name



Please keep this sign because we will be using it the rest of the year.

As you pull into our loop a staff member will read your sign, get on the walkie-talkie, and someone in the gym or cafeteria will send your student out. Yes, this will take more time than usual but it will keep everyone safe. We appreciate everyone's patience.

Learning Expectations

Expect to continue to see a Learning Plan shared with you by Monday morning via email and reflected in Seesaw.

Because we are prioritizing in-person instruction and that can set students up for much of their meaningful work and learning, expect to see 2-4 Seesaw assignments per week, likely focused on literacy and math.

If your child needs to quarantine or be out due to illness, you will work with your child's teacher to continue their learning. We will not be livestreaming lessons, and we will not be transferring students to a distance learning classroom for short term absences such as this.

All students will now have a live morning meeting together with ALL their classmates on Wednesday mornings.

Helping Your Child Be Prepared

Your child may bring a backpack to school with them. They should bring the materials requested by their teacher. We will need the whiteboards returned to school. Some grade levels, will need their Chromebook and charger. Again, the teachers will let you know.

You have already been asked in the fall to purchase school supplies for use at home. For the in person instruction, we're covering what they need for their time on campus.

Water bottles are highly encouraged as our drinking fountains can't be used. Your child may bring them back and forth to fill and clean regularly.

Please feel free to pack a healthy, easy-to-eat snack. Teachers will share with students their snack procedure, which will likely be consumed outside during a movement break.

Your child should come to campus and onto the bus wearing a mask. If they don't have one, one will be provided for them.

When visiting campus - physical distancing and masking are required on school grounds for all visitors (parents, older siblings, etc.)


No volunteers and visitors are allowed to visit classrooms this year, nor can parents travel beyond office doors under any circumstances. Thank you for understanding.

Health Info: from Nurse Jessica

In preparation for hybrid learning, here are a few reminders to help you and your child make a smooth transition from distance learning to in-person learning.

1. Prior to your child's first day of hybrid learning, please provide the following to the school nurse:

- **Completed medical documents: ([Health Documents](#))** If your student has a life threatening health condition or medication that needs to be at school, please make sure that your paperwork is completed, signed by both you and the doctor, and that medications are at school before your child's first day of hybrid learning. Due to state laws, students with life threatening conditions cannot begin in-person instruction until these are in place for the safety of your child.
- **Up to date vaccinations: ([Required for In-Person Learning](#))**
- **Medications: ([Medication Administration Authorization](#))**

No medications can be used at school (including cough drops) without a doctor's order.

2. Wear your favorite mask to school

- Encourage your child to practice wearing a mask for 3 hours a day. This will help them get acclimated to wearing it throughout their school day. Face shields alone should not be considered an alternative to face masks.
- Pack an extra mask should something happen to the first mask.

3. Completion of daily attestation

- **Each morning, parents are required to complete a daily attestation for each child prior to their arrival.**
- If this attestation is not completed prior to arrival, our staff will be calling to have you complete it before your child can be in class.
- Please verify that your phone numbers are current on Skyward should we need to contact you.

4. Please keep your child home if they are sick

- If your child is experiencing a fever, chills, headache, cough, having difficulty breathing, has a sore throat, congestion, runny nose, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea or is not feeling well, keep them home to rest.
- If a child is displaying any of these symptoms while in school, a parent/guardian will be contacted to bring the child home. ([COVID Protocol Flowsheet](#); [Close Contact Chart](#); [Not A Close Contact Chart](#))

5. Food prior to school

- Provide your child with food prior to going to school so they are better prepared to learn.
