Hello HomeLink Families!

August 21st, 2020

The first day of school, September 2nd, is quickly approaching and there is time sensitive information that will need to be submitted and verified to ensure your student is able to start classes with HomeLink. As mentioned in the August 10th letter emailed to families, forms need to be turned in one week prior to the first day of school to allow for processing. The turn in date is August 26th.

Parents/guardians of returning students must complete the required annual District and required ALE forms needed to finalize your students enrollment with HomeLink. These forms may be downloaded from the links below, on the HomeLink webpage or available to pick up in the HomeLink office. If you are unsure which forms to submit, please complete and submit all forms listed below. ***If your student/s will not be returning to HomeLink, notify the office of your plans so your child can be withdrawn.***

Kindergarten families who only submitted the District Enrollment packet and new families with students who have transferred from another LSSD school will also need to complete the required ALE forms and our Volunteer Application, if you have not done so.

Again, forms need to be returned 1 week prior to classes starting to allow time for processing, which is Wednesday, August 26, 2020. Forms may be dropped off during HomeLink office hours or scanned and emailed to our registrar, jen_mcphee@lkstevens.wednet.edu.

Introducing our New HomeLink Teacher Mrs. Beeler

My name is Amy Beeler, and I will be teaching Sharon Stilwell's classes this year. I wanted you to know that if your child is signed up for any of my classes, they will be well taken care of! I have been planning, organizing supplies, and preparing daily. I am extremely excited to meet you and your children, and while we will start out in a distance learning model, I will be pouring in as much fun as I can!

I have been teaching for 7 years; 2 years as a 4th grade teacher, and the last 5 as an elementary art teacher. I have also subbed in just about everything from Kindergarten to high school. While this year has a great deal of unknowns, all of us at Homelink will be putting in as much fun, creativity, and learning as possible!

HomeLink Fall 2020 Distance Learning Program

Many of you have questions about the remote learning plans for HomeLink. Our teachers have come together to make a meaningful guide to how remote learning will look at HomeLink. If you have additional questions, you are welcome to address them at your students WSLP meeting next week.

- A chromebook is issued to each individual student for 1:1 technology to student learning.
- A consistent mode of communication with families and students about their learning through the streamlined use of Google Classroom in all HomeLink classes.
- Students will meet with each HomeLink class on an A/B schedule. Each child will be on either an A or B schedule.
- Classes that are scheduled once weekly will meet for “live” lessons every other week. Classes that are scheduled twice weekly will meet once a week for “live” lessons. Individual teachers will lay out a specific structure for their classes. (small group time, recorded lessons, activities, etc.) See tables below for these two schedules.
- Class meetings will happen at the times they are listed on the current 2020-2021 HomeLink schedule. “Live” online class sessions may end earlier than published, but will start at their scheduled time. This will allow for transition back to hybrid and in-person learning when it is deemed safe.
- Students will be provided with a bi-weekly menu of both online and off-screen activities. These menus will reinforce and expand content presented and learned in their “live” online lessons. Students will be provided feedback on completed menu activities by their teacher.
- Students are required to have weekly contact with their teachers due to state regulations governing alternative learning. This will be done through “live” lessons on their scheduled week and communication around and completion of bi-weekly menu activities.
