If you are new to HomeLink, welcome to you as well. I'm sure that you will find HomeLink to be a warm and welcoming place, with great students and families.

All parents will need to sign in using the SAFE VISITOR kiosk. Students will sign in electronically when they arrive on campus after they receive their badges. It is important that everyone remembers to sign out as well.

Parents/visitors If you don't have a HomeLink badge, you will need to print a safe visitor badge for the day. After picture day, please be sure to wear your badge and sign in and out daily. We are working on a barcode system for sign in/out for students as well

September Monthly Progress: Families will receive September Monthly Progress reports in their mailboxes for each enrolled student. This Monthly Progress will need to be signed and returned to Jen McPhee by October 4th.
