



Request for Approval to earn required community service hours with an organization that is *not* qualified as “non-profit.”

“Community service fosters civic responsibility by providing you with the opportunity to involve yourself in a variety of enriching, useful, and practical experiences which serve the school and community.”

In addition to becoming aware of the needs of others and learning the importance of unselfish serving and giving, community service also provides students with valuable opportunities to learn new skills, expose students to situations outside their previous experiences, gain connections, and to prepare for the professional world.

Although the LSHS graduation requirements specify that students must fulfill 45 hours of community service with a NON-PROFIT organization, there are occasionally unique opportunities available for students which are offered through businesses that do not fall under a “non-profit” variety. Some of these possibilities may provide students with a unique opportunity to gain experiences that relate to their prospective job field. It is in this instance that students may request **pre-approval** to earn required community service hours through an organization that is not “non-profit” by filling out the bottom of this form and turning it into the Career Center for **pre-approval**.

Approval must be granted prior to beginning your service and service cannot be done with a business that you have been or are employed with.
