

Lake Stevens School District Policy On Personally Owned Computers

The District does **NOT** allow personally owned computers to be connected to the District's Network at any time for the following reasons:

- The District has a standard suite of security (client) and anti-virus software which must be installed on all machines connected to the network. The District does not buy software licenses for personally owned computers.
- Legally the District cannot expend resources on personally owned computers. It is an unacceptable expenditure of public funds in support of privately owned equipment.

All personally owned computers must be clearly labeled as:
"Personal Property of _____ (first and last name)".
