

STUDENT MEDICAL EVALUATIONS

POLICY:

Optimal health is essential for maximum utilization of educational opportunities. Therefore, the health status of a child bears a direct relationship to the quality of his educational experience.

Lake Stevens School District principals will encourage parents to provide the school with a medical evaluation of their child performed by the family physician when their child enters kindergarten and/or first grade and had not attended school before. The information is to be filed with the attending school prior to enrolling in the fall.

In addition, all students in the district will be required to have current emergency locator cards on file in the school office. These should be completed upon enrollment and updated on a regular basis.
